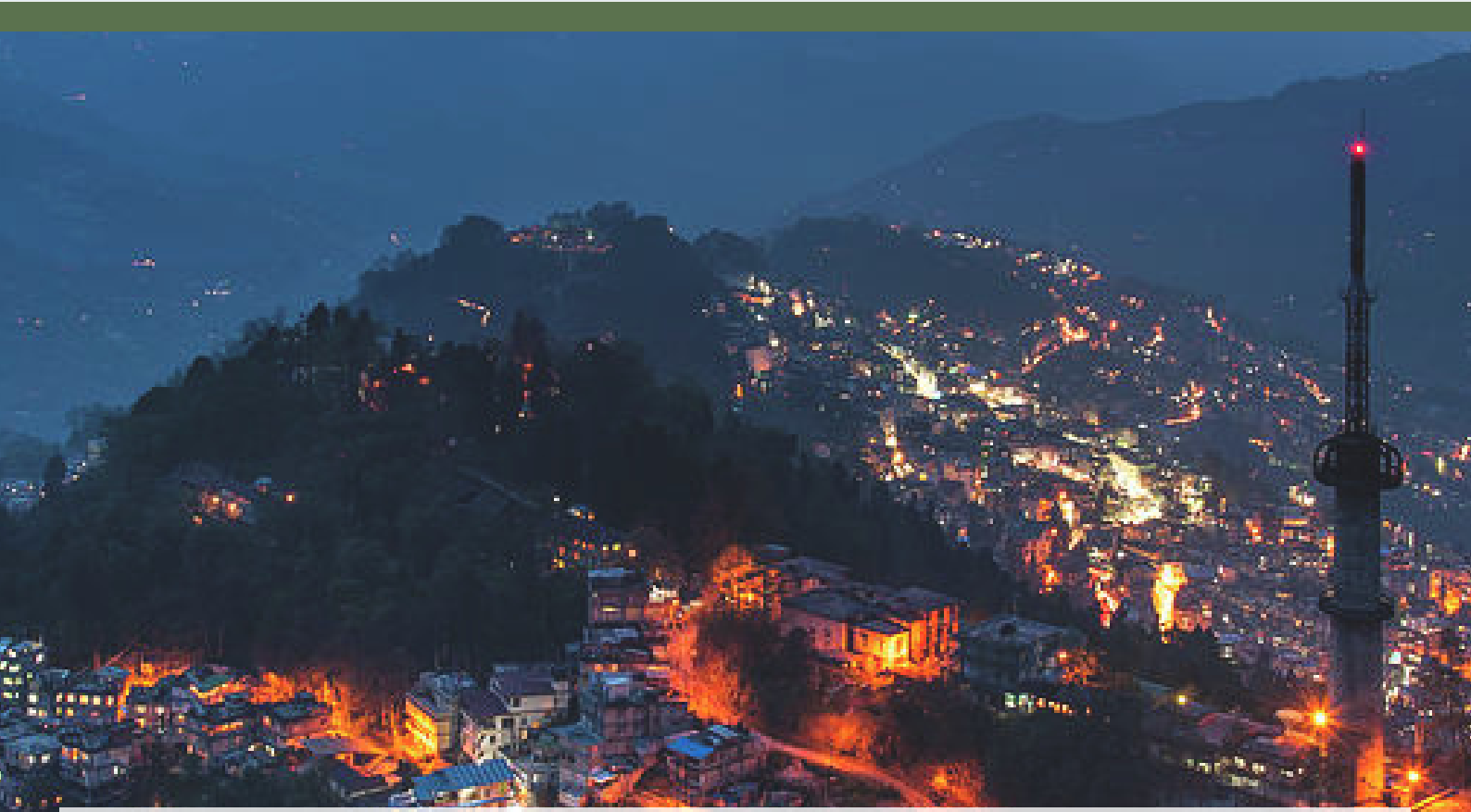

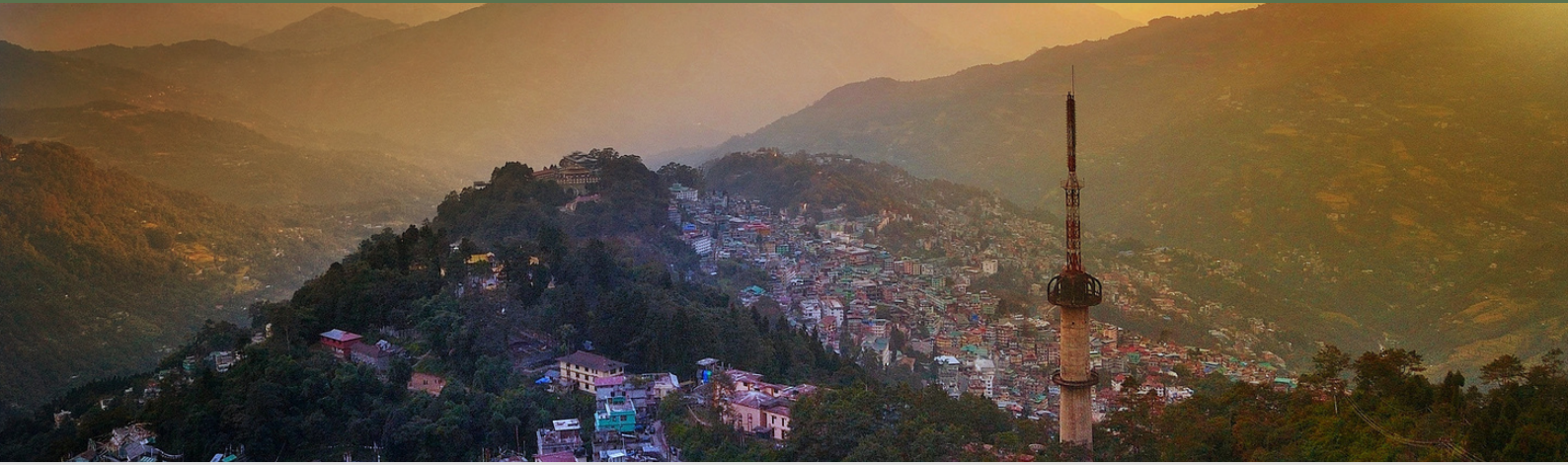
UNEXPLORED TOURIST ATTRACTION UNVEILING DZULUK: A HIDDEN GEM

Perched at an altitude of approximately 10,000 feet amidst the rugged terrain of East Sikkim's lower Himalayas, Dzuluk (also spelled Zuluk, Jhuluk, or Jaluk) is a quaint hamlet gaining recognition as an emerging offbeat destination. Historically, it served as a pivotal transit point along the Silk Route from Tibet to India, boasting breathtaking vistas of the eastern Himalayan mountain range, including the majestic Kanchenjunga. Today, with its serene ambiance and burgeoning tourism infrastructure, Dzuluk invites visitors to explore its pristine wilderness, offering glimpses of indigenous wildlife and vibrant rhododendron blooms during the summer months.

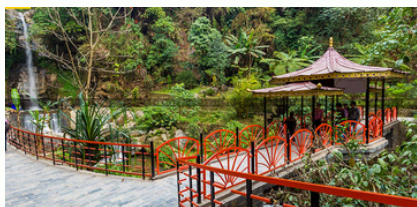


BURTUK HELIPAD

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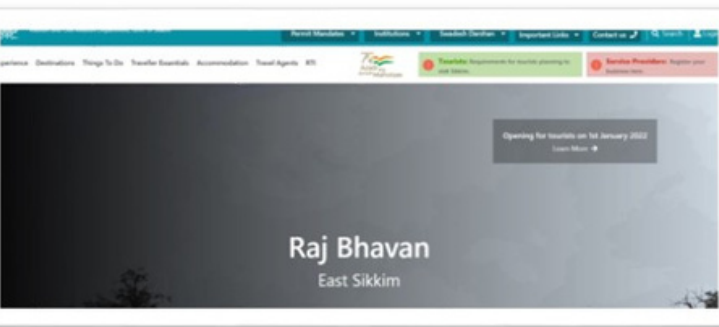
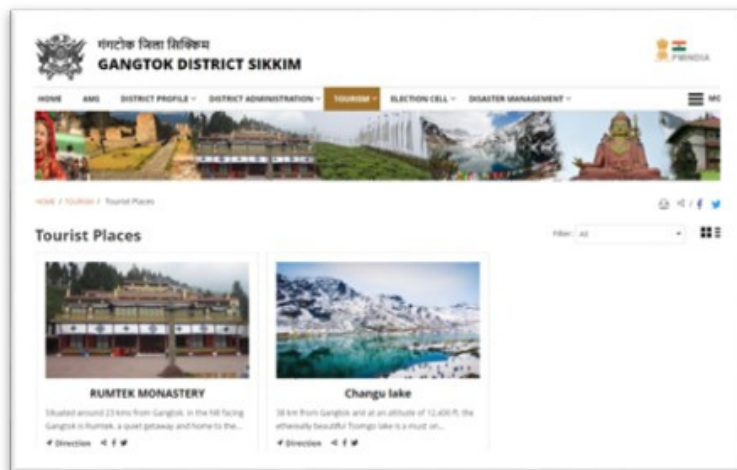
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
